


We work together and understand the importance of learning new things to broaden our minds.

First Clark jumps in his chair when the teacher is talking, he eats all the lunches of his classmates and he plays too rough-to-rough.


Next the other classmates don't want to play with Clark because he plays too rough-to-rough and eats their food.
