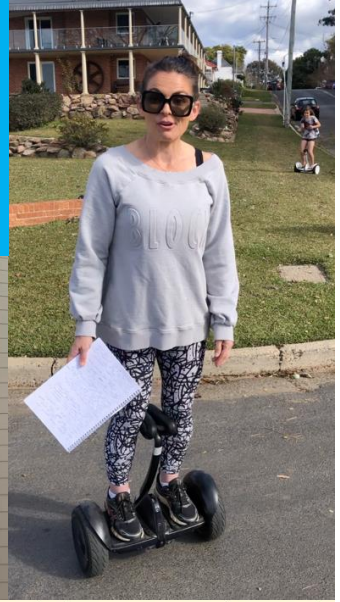

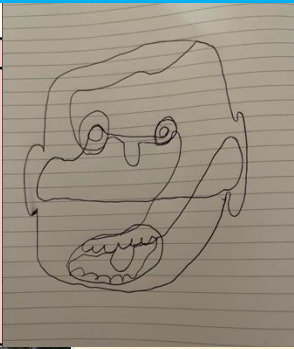

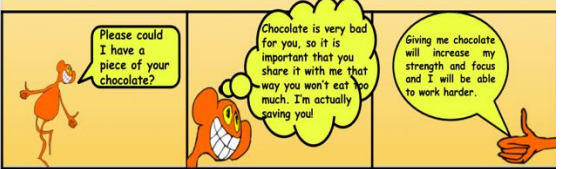

You are going to create a comic strip with a character trying to persuade someone to do something. See the example I have created for you below- the character is trying to convince you to share your chocolate with him. (Don't do it!). Go to the 'Insert' tab above, select 'Image', then 'search the web' - type in what you are looking for and insert your image. To add a speech bubble go to 'Insert', select 'shape', then 'callouts'. You can type straight into this, or add a text box. Consider including high modality, convincing words, and what persuasive arguments to convince the reader.

Attempt your comic on the next page. There are 6 panels to use.



WHY THREE???

You are often required to come up with three examples, write three paragraphs, use three adjectives in your writing. Have you ever wondered why this is the case? There is something known as the 'Rule of Three'. Three is the smallest number to create a pattern, and humans process information in patterns. Hence, things in threes are considered more persuasive.

The Rule of Three is a writing technique that suggests that a group of three adjectives or examples is always stronger and more memorable than one. For example, saying that something is 'dark, cold and dingy' is more engaging than saying something is just 'dark'.

Come up with three adjectives for the following words-

dog	The <u>large and tall, brown, rottweiler</u> barked at everything passing by.
ship	The <u>huge, red, metal vessel</u> took off and set sail to Antarctica.
garden	The <u>light pink tulips</u> started to sprout in the <u>small, brown, wooden flower bed</u> .
potato	The <u>chef</u> despised the <u>dirty but sweet, purple yam</u> .
hair	The <u>long, luscious, blonde locks</u> danced and sparkled in the gleaming sunlight.

Thermal energy- Rubbing your hands together

- Rub your hands together consistently for two minutes

Colour	Symbol	Image
Explain why you chose this colour: I chose this colour because I consider it to be a colour that represents personal growth. Percy, although frightened, faces his fears and becomes a stronger character throughout the novel.	Explain why you chose this symbol: This symbol shows Percy's strength, but also that he is vulnerable.	Explain why this image from your book best represents your character: This is where Percy is attacked, and has to decide whether to flee or face the antagonist.

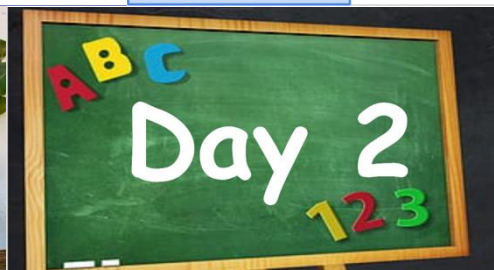
