English:

Theme: Earth and Space

Stage 3 students will be focusing on the Earth's solar system, changes on its surface caused by natural disasters and the exploration of how these may be migrated. Stage 3 students will also further develop their understanding of the Earth, its position in the solar system and as a dynamic part of a complex, interrelated system.

History:

Themes: Year 5: Australian Colonies and Year 6: Australia as a Nation

Year 5 look at the Migration to the Australian Colonies, Colonial life and the shaping of these colonies. Students of year 6 explore federation and democracy through their research in Australia becoming a nation. Students will use google slides and the Google Classroom as a tool for these units.

Creative and Performing Arts – CAPA

Main Focus: Drama

Students use movement, voice and the elements of drama to sustain dramatic roles in a range of contexts.

They devise and perform a range of drama forms for audiences. Students interpret a range of drama experiences by making, performing and appreciating drama.

Personal Development, Health and Physical Education - PDHPE

Health, Wellbeing and Relationships – Stage 3 will developing their knowledge, understanding and skills important for building relationships, enhancing personal strengths. Students will focus on strategies to manage change, mental health and wellbeing.
