English This term in English, the students will be learning about Narratives (in the form of Fairy Tales) in weeks 1-5 and Persuasive Writing (Expositions) in weeks 6-9. Students will learn about the structure and language features of writing a narrative and an exposition, as well as creating and developing their own Fairy Tales and Expositions that they will be publishing. The students will also be exposed to a wide variety of rich texts that their writing will relate to.	MathematicsThe students in Stage One will continue to develop their whole number concepts on a daily basis. The topics to be covered this term are:• Addition and Subtraction• Multiplication and Division• Factions and Decimals• Patterns and Algebra• Capacity, Time and 3D Objects• Position and Chance	Science This term in Science, students will be learning about Earth and Space as well as Digital Technologies. Students will explore the changes that occur both on the land and in the sky as well as natural and human changes. Students will be participating in an experiment involving animal tracks and will learn how to record reliable results. Seasonal patterns will also be a focus in Science this term.	History During History, students will be investigating how technology has changed over time and the impacts of changing technology. Students will discuss the similarities and differences of technology from the past and sequence them over time. Students will explore the way technology has changed the way we communicate and the impacts of this on people's lives.
Personal Development and Health This term in PDHPE, students will explore the choices they can make to ensure their environments are safe and healthy. Students will learn about the different food groups and how healthy food choices can lead to positive wellbeing.
