We gifted flowers to show our appreciation and thank them for their continued support of the P&C during their time at Pitt Town PS.

Overview of Previous Meeting

Thank you to everyone who attended the meeting held on the 15th June.

Some important things to note are listed below:

- Mrs Roche provided us with some updates on the construction at school – the wombat crossing has been approved, the COLA area has been completed, and the outdoor learning furniture has been purchased. The back gate shelter was finalised at the end of Term 2, and the OOSH hub is set to go ahead.
- The fundraising pavers have arrived, and will hopefully be laid in the next few weeks.
- Stewart House was chosen for the Charity Box for Term 3. See below for more information about our new initiative.
- Quoting is currently underway to fix the long jump pit.
- Votes held – yes to purchase rugby jerseys for inter-school sport, and yes to reimburse school for purchase of roses.
- Discussion about purchase of other sport uniforms as/if required.

Charity Box

The P&C are setting up a Charity Box to be kept outside of the canteen. The idea behind this initiative is to raise funds for a different charity each term, suggested by and voted upon by members, with funds topped up by the P&C at the end of the term.

We are hoping to encourage the students to think of others and to donate their canteen change to the box. Each term, they will learn a little about the chosen charity, and will have the opportunity to consider those who may be in a position less fortunate than them. We encourage you to have these discussions with your children at home as well, and are hoping that you will help to make this initiative a success.

The chosen charity for Term 3 is Stewart House. Stewart House is a charitable foundation and centre for children, based in Curl Curl. Each year 1,700 public school children in need go to Stewart House from many parts of NSW and the ACT. During their stay, children are provided with optometric, dental and medical treatment as well as emotional support. 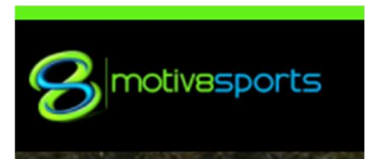
